Throughout the school year, staff will conduct four study sessions to share important information with the school board and the community. This information will include student progress and will be conducted into four parts: Quarter 1, Quarter 2, Quarter 3, and Quarter 4. Quarter 1, will show student progress in the previous 2022-2023 school year which is referred to as "lag data." Quarters 2, 3, and 4, will show student progress during the current school year and determine if change is needed to help them excel. This information is referred to as "lead data." Staff will share data as listed below:

Quarter 2: November

Quarter 3: March

Quarter 4: June as part of the LCAP adoption.

On August 24th, staff will present data from Quarter 1 which will allow the board to review and discuss student's progress during the 2022-2023 school year. This will help identify the areas of weakness as well as strengths. This will guide the board in the decision making process regarding policies.

- 4.1 CONTRACT APPROVAL OF AERIES COMMUNICATION POWERED BY PARENT SQUARE:** It is proposed that the Board of Education approve the contract for Parent Square as presented on the attachment.

In order to enhance parents, students, staff, community engagement and mass communication, staff is recommending acquisition and implementation of Aeries communication powered by Parent Square. This program will replace the BlackBoard communication system with full implementation in the 2024-2025 school year. During the 2023-2024 school year, staff will pilot Parent Square at Mayfair Middle/High School, Bellflower Middle/High School, and Frank E. Woodruff.
